

ACADEMIC GRADUATION CHECKLIST

This checklist will help you stay on track for graduation. You may find it helpful to keep with your audit sheets to refer to during advising meetings. Refer to it as needed, keeping in mind that you are responsible for meeting these requirements.

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Declare a major by the end of your sophomore year by completing a Major Declaration form. You and your	
advisor will then be sent an official degree audit sheet. Failure to declare in a timely manner may affect your	
financial aid.	
If declaring an optional minor, use the Minor Declaration/Change form.	
Update your Audit Sheets each semester with your advisor.	
Complete the General Education requirements	
Complete your Major requirements (including any related Concentration or Minor)	
- Grades must be C- or better (C for Education and Music Education).	
 Half of the credit hours in your major must be completed at Houghton University. 	
Complete your Minor requirements	
- Grades must be a C- or better.	
Complete Liberal Arts: minimum of 93 LA credits for the BA degree, 62 LA credits for the BS degree, 32 LA	
credits for the BMus degree, and 31 LA credits for the BFA degree.	
Multiple majors: You must complete the Liberal Arts credit requirement for the major with the higher minimum.	
Submit your <u>Diploma Order Form</u> by February 1 st of your senior year. You must contact the Registrar's Office if	
you plan to graduate early.	
Complete a minimum of 124 hours for a BA/BS/BFA, or 128 hours for a BMus degree.	
Maintain a 2.0 grade point average, or better.	
Complete 30 credit hours at Houghton University.	
Complete 18 of the last 24 credit hours at Houghton University.	
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NOTES:

- A student must complete at least one major. A minor is not required unless a specific major requires a specific minor.
- No more than 8 credits of Horsemanship may count toward graduation unless the student is a SRWM major with an Equestrian emphasis, or is pursuing an Equestrian Studies minor.
- No more than 8 credits of ROTC (unless pursuing a Military Studies minor) or Theatre Workshop may count toward graduation.
- No more than 8 credit hours of Applied Music may count toward graduation for students who are not majoring or minoring in Music.

For example: A student earning 12 Horsemanship credits will need <u>128</u> total credits in order to graduate unless majoring in SRWM with an Equestrian emphasis or minoring in Equestrian Studies. A student earning 10 credits with ROTC will need 126 total credits in order to graduate.

DEGREE CONFERRAL: Degrees are officially conferred three times each year: May, August, and December. If you have work that is finished after the conferral date, your diploma will be conferred on the next conferral date.

*** Attention transfer students! You must earn at least 62 hours from HU to receive graduation honors. To be eligible to be valedictorian or salutatorian, you must be a main campus student, full-time in the spring, a May graduate, and have earned a minimum of 90 Houghton University credits. ***
